The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern and Western Districts of Arkansas is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Judicial Law Clerk to Federal Bankruptcy Judge Richard D. Taylor. The estimated start date for the position is August 2018, negotiable. The position is for a two year term.

Qualifications: Applicants must be law school graduates or be graduating in May 2018 and possess demonstrative skills in legal research, writing, and computer processing. Travel will be required for the position. Applicants must possess proficient keyboard skills. Applicants with a law school class rank in the top 20% and law review membership or other law journal experience are preferred, but not required.

Benefits: Subsidized life and health insurance, 10 paid holidays per calendar year

Other Requirements: The position is subject to mandatory Electronic Funds Transfer of net pay. The position is a Sensitive position within the federal judiciary. Employment will be considered provisional pending successful completion of an FBI fingerprint check. Employees of the judiciary are at-will employees. Judiciary employees are required to adhere to the Judicial Code of Conduct. Applicants must be citizens of the United States or be eligible to work in the United States.
