7. Chapter 13 Agreed Order Sustaining Objection to Exemption
8. Chapter 13 Order Canceling Insurance
9. Chapter 13 Order Withdrawing Trustee's Objection To Confirmation
10. Chapter 13 Order Dismissing Case For Exceeding Five Years, For Non-Compliance Of A Strict Compliance Order, Or Non-Payment Of Plan Payments
11. Order Granting Extension Of Time Based On A Strict Compliance Order Generated By A Chapter 13 Trustee
12. Chapter 13 Order Revoking Final Report
13. Chapter 13 Order Canceling Credit Union And Other Similar Deductions
14. Chapter 13 Order Reinstating Credit Union And Other Similar Deductions
15. Chapter 13 Order Withdrawing Objection To Exemption
16. Chapter 13 Order To Provide Documentation
17. Chapter 13 Order to Modify Chapter 13 Plan

28. Chapter 13 Dismissal Order after hearing on Trustee's Motion to Dismiss for Failure to Make Plan Payments
29. Chapter 13 Order of Dismissal when Debtor fails to comply with previous strict compliance order directing Debtor to make full and timely plan payments.
30. Chapter 13 Order of Dismissal when Debtor fails to comply with Order Withdrawing Trustee's Motion to Dismiss Case for Failure to Make Payments upon conditions
31. Orders Granting the Chapter 13 Trustee's Motion for Additional Time to File an Objection to Confirmation of Debtor(s)' Plan

ORDERED that the Clerk and the Standing Chapter 13 Trustees in Bankruptcy for the Eastern and Western Districts of Arkansas administer and process the routine orders enumerated above. It is further
