
General Order No. 14 dated April 1, 1998, is hereby revoked.


Pursuant to Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 3015(f), 9014, and 202(b), IT IS
HEREBY ORDERED that objections to confirmation of the debtor's plan in chapter 13
bankruptcy cases must be filed with the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court and served on the Chapter
13 Trustee and the debtor on or before the tenth (10th) day after the 341(a) meeting of creditors is
concluded. The Clerk shall give notice to creditors as required by the applicable rule in the
341(a) meeting notice. If no objections to confirmation are filed within the time fixed in the
341(a) hearing notice, the plan will be confirmed without further notice or a hearing.


This Order shall be effective on and after December 17, 2001.
